- Deliver a curriculum which is ambitious, creative and engaging, meeting the needs of all children.
- Provide information regarding your child's intended curriculum coverage each term.
- Inform parents of their child's progress at regular meetings.
- Promote positive behaviour in line with our Behaviour Policy.
- Contact parents if there are concerns with attendance, punctuality, behaviour, health or homework.

Families Will...

- Encourage children to talk about their school day and support them in participating fully in school life.
- Support children with homework and opportunities for learning both at home and at school.
- Inform school of any problems that might affect children's work or behaviour.
- Attend meetings to discuss children's progress.
- Support the school's behaviour policy.
- Ensure that children have the correct school uniform and equipment.
- Ensure that children arrive on time and attend regularly, informing school of any absence.
- Treat staff and school premises with respect.
- Regularly check emails and school website for important updates.
- Be considerate and do not park anywhere which will block access to homes, roads or school access.
